As the region's lead industry representative voice to government, C4G brings together groups representing various business and industry views and Gippsland communities. The Gippsland Community Leadership Program



The Gippsland Community Leadership Program (GCLP) is a comprehensive leadership experience offering participants exposure to a deep contextual understanding of our region while enhancing individual leadership skills.

GCLP was established in 1996 and is one of Australia's longest running regional leadership programs. More than 650 Gippslanders have graduated from the program and have gone on to represent their communities as diverse, talented and passionate community leaders.

GCLP is one of 10 regional leadership programs and is supported by the State Government and local sponsors.

GCLP is a ten-month experiential program delivered through meeting, interacting and working with the region's finest leaders, designing and delivering community projects and gaining skills and knowledge to build participant community leadership capacity.

Eligibility

We actively recruit for a diverse cohort each year and encourage applications from all over Gippsland including people of all abilities, from diverse industry, First Nations people, LGBTQI+ and community members from a non-English speaking background.

People of all ages with a demonstrated eagerness to contribute to the community and develop leadership skills are encouraged to apply for the Gippsland Community Leadership Program.

To be eligible, candidates will:

- Demonstrate leadership potential
- Show a genuine interest and involvement in their community
- Commit time to meet challenges of the program year
- Make a pledge to aspire to take a leading role in their community
- Reside in one of the six Gippsland local government areas

Program Outline

- Program introduction and launch
- Four residentials (three days, two nights each)
- Ten program days (different locations and themes, across Gippsland)

The GCLP experience is one of self-growth via reflective, collaborative and hands-on participation. The program includes personal and professional milestones which includes group work, individual challenges, and observational learning, as well as:

- Enhance positive leadership skills
- Build public speaking experience
- Be encouraged to find opportunities, take risks in a safe and inclusive environment
- Work with a strength-based mindset and collaboration
- Be connected to a dynamic leadership network

The uniqueness of C4G's program relates to its ability to reflect the diversity of our region among the participants. This means the final selection will result in a blend of participants which come from all over Gippsland to reflect a broad range of ages, backgrounds, and experience.



General Requirements:

- Willingness to commit to time and travel requirements of the program
- Ability to meet the financial commitment
- Demonstrated evidence of your employer's support for you to undertake the program's time and travel commitments
- Ability to meet minimum 80% attendance
- Ability to attend all four Gippsland residential sessions
- Ability to attend out of region program events (i.e. Melbourne)

Program Fees

The total fee for the 2023 Program is \$6,600* plus GST.

The fee* is made up of:

- A participant contribution of \$600 plus GST
- A workplace sponsorship fee of \$6,000 plus GST

Sole Trader / Individual (with no supporting workplace) \$3,500.00 plus GST

*The fee is to be paid in full prior to commencement of the program unless a payment plan is negotiated. It covers program costs, including: program day expenses, facilitators, resources and catering, accommodation and other costs associated with the four residentials. The fee also includes two tickets for the participant and their sponsor to attend GCLP graduation ceremony. Shared travel to program days is encouraged to increase connection, and minimise costs associated with travel.
